These 295 species have been reported from the Wells National Estuarine Research Reserve since record-keeping began in the 1980s. Reports have been compiled from numerous sources. While most species are well documented, a few (\*) remain tentative. Names and sequence follow the American Ornithological Society Check-list of North American Birds (online), 7th edition, 62nd supplement.

The Wells Reserve encompasses 2,250 acres of diverse habitats, including field, woodland, salt marsh, and beach. The reserve also incorporates most of Wells Harbor. Portions of the reserve are included in the Wells Important Bird Area. While not formally part of the Wells Reserve, nearshore waters off Laudholm Beach are included for this list.
